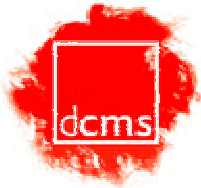

The Talented Athlete Scholarship Scheme, (TASS) and the World Cycling Centre (WCC) in Switzerland, have joined forces to create a unique secondment opportunity for an experienced Strength and Conditioning Coach.

The three month secondment will see the Strength and Conditioning Coach work with an array of cyclists and coaches from throughout the world. The secondment will be based at the World Cycling Centre, Aigle, Switzerland. The World Cycling Centre, home of the Union Cyclisme International (UCI), the international body for cycling, is also an International Olympic Committee recognised training centre.

The Strength and Conditioning Coach will fit into the existing Coaching team and work across programmes aimed at developing current and future talented cyclists and coaches via two World Cycling Centre programmes.

Applicants should be a member of the TASS Strength and Conditioning Community, hold accredited status with the United Kingdom Strength and Conditioning Association and have at least 3 years coaching experience with talented athletes on national performance programmes.
